



LOCATION

The South Australian College of English (SACE) is located in Adelaide, South Australia. The campus is situated in the city centre only 5- minute walk to the mall, shops, restaurants, cafes, public transport and beautiful parklands.



Adelaide, South Australia

- Adelaide is the capital of South Australia and has a population of 1.2 million people.
- Adelaide is the Gateway to the Great Australian Outback and Uluru.
- Adelaide is known as the Festival City because of its many and varied festivals which celebrate regional food, wine, art and music.
- The city of Adelaide is beautifully located between the picturesque Adelaide Hills and sweeping sandy beaches.

- Adelaide was ranked #3 most liveable by Economist Intelligence Unit (2021) and named most beautiful city by Architectural Digest (2024), with Kangaroo Island recognized by Lonely Planet.

GETTING THERE

Direct flights available to Adelaide International Airport with Qantas, Emirates, Singapore Airlines, Cathay Pacific, Malaysian Airlines, Southern China Airlines, Air New Zealand and Qatar Airlines. Qantas, Jetstar, Virgin Australia and Tiger Air also offer direct flights from most mainland capital cities. The Adelaide Airport is located 20 minutes by car from the city centre.

CLIMATE

The climate in Adelaide is similar to that in the Mediterranean. It is dry and mild in summer with most of the rain fall in the winter months. The average temperature in summer is 30+°C and in winter 15°C.

TRANSPORT

Full-time students are issued with a student card which entitles them to a 50% discount on the City Bus Service

WORKING IN ADELAIDE

SACE Students find casual work in cafés, restaurants, hotels and/or fruit picking. SACE assists students with job search, resume writing etc.

ACCOMMODATION

HOMESTAY: Full board including 3 meals per day. Shared rooms available for two students travelling together. Minimum booking 4 weeks or for the entire length of the students’ course if shorter.
